### Leveraged gold play into mid-tier firm

Sean Roosen, president and chief executive of Osisko Mining Corp. was named Ernst & Young Entrepreneur Of The Year 2011 for Quebec at a gala event in Montreal on Oct. 6. Mr. Roosen also won in the business-to-business products and services category.

"Sean [Roosen] is a true entrepreneur in action," said François Dufresne, partner and Quebec director of Entrepreneur Of The Year. "Through strong leadership and vision, he effectively orchestrated Osisko's development from exploration to development, and, ultimately, to operations in the second quarter of 2011."

While other companies were pulling back during the financial downturn, Mr. Roosen was determined to bring Osisko — a development-stage gold mining company currently completing the construction of the Canadian Malartic, one of Canada's largest gold deposits — to a new level and overcome important challenges.

While junior exploration companies will typically divest their discoveries to large mining companies, he resolved to leverage Canadian Malartic into a new mid-tier Canadian mining company.
